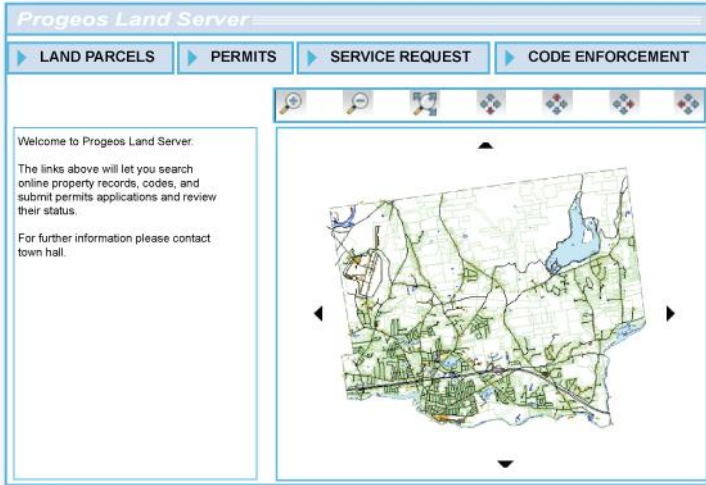

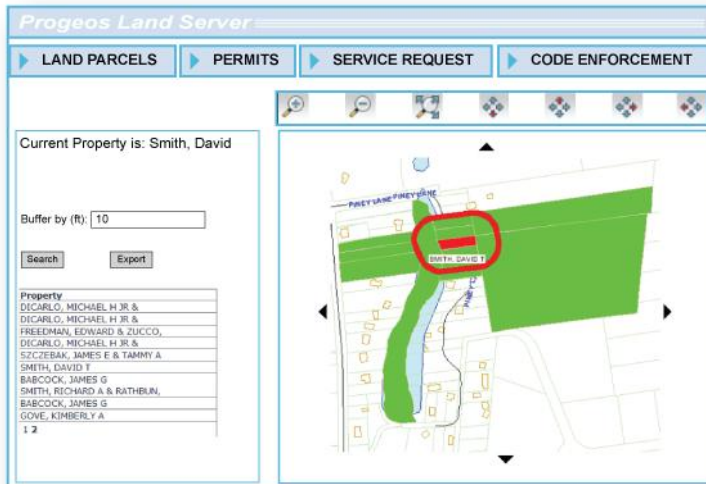
Reducing the Cost and Time to find Abutting Parcels



The capability to rapidly generate an accurate abutters list from an up-to-date online mapping system can save countless hours for municipal employees, reduce possible errors and provide increased customer service for residents in their home or business.

Searching for parcel abutter information can be a tedious and time consuming task. Abutters' lists are used for many municipal tasks including notifying residents in the cases of proposed construction, code enforcement or environmental assessments.

Generating abutters data through an online program saves time for both town employees researching the data and residents requesting the data.



Creating Abutters Lists

Progeos' Property Manager parcel mapping tools, accessible through any internet connection, can be used to calculate a property's abutters quickly and easily. First, select the property that is in question. This can be done by either using the select tool or by searching for a property by owner name or address.

Once the property of interest is selected, the user can search for all abutting property using the Property Manager Abutter search tool. The user is returned a mailing list of the abutters and a pdf map of the selected property and the abutters. The mailing list can be used to notify neighbors about permit applications, code violations, environmental assessment or other items of interest.

Additional information such as abutter's names and addresses can also be obtained from Progeos' abutter search tool. By integrating property data from several municipal departments, employees and residents can access accurate up-to-date information with the click of a mouse and an internet connection. The Progeos online abutter tool saves valuable time and money for a municipality and for its residents.
